

## Coding Guidelines for the NasoNeb® Nasal Nebulizer System

The NasoNeb® Nasal Nebulizer is typically billed through the DME benefit using the assigned HCPCS codes, but there is now an option for processing claims through PBM systems using UPC/NDC codes.

The NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer has been assigned the following HCPCS codes:

<u>HCPCS code</u>	<u>Description</u>
E0570	Nebulizer with compressor
A7005	Non-disposable nebulizer set

Some PBMs may accept the UPC/NDC codes for billing purposes:

<u>Model Number</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>UPC/NDC</u>
Model 5070	NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer Starter Kit	8911700000
Model 5080	NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer Handheld Replacement Device	8911700001

Not all PBMs will accept the UPC/NDC codes.

The NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer UPC/NDC listings are standard 5-4-2 scheme codes. Some PBMs may report these as missing or invalid codes. This can be corrected by adding a 0 in the appropriate place in the codes:

CMS processes claims for the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer through the DME benefit. Therefore, the DME HCPCS codes must be used with Medicare and Medicaid prescriptions.
